REMEMBERING HISTORY HIGHLIGHTS in

Friendship, Charity & Benevolence

In this year, a century milestone for Albany City Lodge, we pause to reflect on some highlights, starting with prior milestone celebrations. For those of our brothers who were active in the 1970s, we last celebrated our 50th anniversary in 1975 under the then Chancellor Commander Stephen Grobman. We held a well-attended dinner dance with a cocktail hour at the Italian American Community Center. The Chairman was Supreme Representative, Leonard A. Weiss.

At that time, records show our Lodge was comprised of about 650 members including Brothers from Peabody Lodge No.32 and Troy City Lodge No. 793 who

had merged with our lodge. We also had an affiliate Pythian organization, The “DOKKIES” (El Jebel Temple No. 166) to which many of our brothers belonged.

Our Lodge was located for many years at 728 Madison Avenue in Albany. That building was purchased in 1958 after 33 years of meeting in eight prior different locations. Our Castle Hall included basement office space for our Federal Credit Union that was established in 1967. We had an upstairs lounge for members cards playing. Beginning in 1973, once a week we ran popular BINGO games open to the community, at which we had hot pizza and refreshments available. Many of our brothers volunteered to work BINGO and the kitchen. A few member teenagers worked as “soda boys or girls” like waiters and waitresses. It was rewarding fun. Our Madison Avenue location was usually a busy Pythian activity place.

On June 3, 2000, we celebrated our seventy-fifth anniversary with a dinner dance at the Marriott Hotel on Wolf Road, under the leadership of Chancellor Commander Michael Stracher. Our membership remained strong with over 400 brothers, many of whom attended the celebration event. It was again chaired by Judge Leonard A Weiss, Past Supreme Representative. Our State Grand Chancellor Bergenfeld also honored our lodge by attending.
